Port Detail

Pier 91 is located at the north end of Seattle's downtown waterfront, just minutes from the city's retail core and historic Pike Place Market. Seattle-Tacoma International Airport is located 17 miles south of Pier 91 - transit time is approximately 40 minutes.

Luggage Handling

Prior to arriving at the pier, please ensure personal identification tags and completed Princess luggage tags are affixed all luggage. Additional Princess tags are available at the pier. Porters will be available to assist you with luggage at the pier. Porters are not Princess employees, and tipping is discretionary. You are responsible for your belongings at all times. For security reasons, please keep your hand luggage, including laptops, cameras, medications, all travel documentation (passports, visas, etc.), and other valuables, in your possession at all times.

Parking Information

- You may prepay for parking on-line through Republic Parking at www.rpnw.com
- Fee is \$25 per day for automobiles and is subject to change without notice.
- Oversize/recreational vehicles are welcome – please refer to Republic Parking website for applicable fees.
- Lot is located 5 minutes from the terminal and offers complimentary shuttle service with luggage handling.

Cell Phone Waiting Lot

A complimentary cell phone waiting lot is available for guests being picked up by private vehicles operated by friends, family, limo services, etc. Please advise private vehicles to proceed to the cell phone waiting lot, located approximately ¼ mile from the terminal building. You should call your party after you have claimed your luggage, processed through U.S. Immigration, and have exited the building. The location of the cell phone waiting lot is depicted on the terminal map on page 3 of this document.


Directions from Interstate 5

1. Exit Interstate 5 at Mercer St. - exit 167
2. Turn right on Fairview Ave. North – travel 200 feet
3. Turn left on Valley St., which bends left and becomes Broad St.
4. Stay in the right-hand lane - turn right on Denny Way
5. Bend right on Western Ave., which joins Elliott Ave. West
6. Follow signs to Magnolia Bridge
7. Turn right at 14th Ave. West (signal light intersection)
8. Stay right and follow ramp to the Magnolia Bridge (West Garfield St.)
9. Proceed ¼ mile, follow signs to "Smith Cove Park" and "Cruise Terminal", exit right
10. Turn right at bottom of ramp and follow signs to parking, cell phone waiting lot or cruise terminal

Day of Visit:

- Please bring your Boarding Pass and Government issued photo identification.
- Please arrive to the off-site parking lot by **10.00 a.m.** A complimentary shuttle will transport you to the terminal.
- When you arrive at the terminal you will be directed to the check-in area on the second level.
- Check-in will begin at **10.30 a.m.**
- You will board the vessel at approximately **11.00 a.m.**
- You will be on board from approximately **11.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.**
- Please be advised that it is imperative that you disembark by **3.00 p.m.**
- Shuttles will depart to the parking lot until **4.00 p .m.**

- Fees are subject to change without notice. Current fee structure is:
 - 0-1 hr = \$5
 - 1-6 hrs = \$10
 - 6-12hrs = \$15

- Please allow 15 minutes for complimentary transit between long-term lot and cruise terminal building.
